Job Description- Afternoon Extended Care Teacher

Qualifications

- At least 18 years of age and high school graduate (or equivalent).
- Ability to meet the requirements of the licensing agency.
- Relates well with children and adults (sensitive and mature).
- Ability to create a Christian atmosphere in the classroom.
- Ability to work as an effective team member of the staff.
- Previous experience in the early childhood education field is preferred.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Help implement lead teacher's lessons and supervise the class in accordance with the policies and the philosophy of the school program.
- Recognize that the environment should meet the needs of the individual child for his/her interests, handicaps, special talents, individual style, and pace of learning.
- Assist with the serving and clean-up of lunch time and afternoon snack time.
- Maintain a professional relationship with each individual child that is characterized by warmth, kindness, caring, positiveness, a sense of humor, and cooperativeness.
- Create an awareness of each child's role as an integral member of the group.
- Help maintain the orderly arrangement, appearance, décor, and learning environment of the classroom.
- Assist in cleaning of classroom to prepare for the next school day.
- Maintain a friendly, but professional relationship with each child's parents.
- Attend all staff meetings and designated training programs, conferences, courses, and other aspects of professional growth.
- Display knowledge of nap time rules and requirements as required by ODJFS.
- Track attendance of children in the classroom and utilize tracking cards.
- Assist lead teacher in preparing of material in room for the next school day.
- Meet deadlines of paperwork, updating training, and event activities.

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- Maintain confidentiality relative to problems and concerns which occur at school.

This position job description is not intended to be all inclusive; therefore, the extended care teacher will also perform other reasonably related duties as assigned by the Director.

Supervision and Evaluation

- The extended care teacher is accountable to the session through the Preschool Director and the Senior Pastor of Mansfield 1st EPC.
- The extended care teacher will be formally evaluated at least once a year by the Preschool Director. The Director may consult with the Senior Pastor as needed.

Non-financial Conditions of Employment

- The standard work week will be 5 hours per day, per days worked, during the program year. Hours may change based on enrolled children's schedules.
- The rate of pay shall be based upon the salary scale.
- Sick Leave:
 - Four paid work days of sick leave per program year on a non-accumulative basis for teachers who work two or less days per week.
 - Five paid work days of sick leave per program year on a non-accumulative basis for teachers who work three days per week.
 - Six paid work days of sick leave per program year on a non-accumulative basis for teachers who work five days per week.
- Bereavement:
 - Three days paid bereavement days for the death of immediate family members per program year on a non-accumulative basis.
